Elizabeth Nelson was born in New York City, and moved to Connecticut with her family.

After graduating from Rhode Island School of Design she lived in Guatemala for a year. She received a Master's degree at the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill. She has lived in northern Vermont for over 50 years and has been a teacher, dairy farmer, museum curator, but always a painter.

She has exhibited throughout Vermont and New England as well as in juried shows in Reykjavik, Iceland, Wisconsin, New York, Kentucky and Pennsylvania. Her work was featured prominently in the "Art of Vermont" exhibit which toured state-wide, including two solo shows at the Vermont Supreme Court gallery. In Burlington City Arts, she was part of a three person show and was included in two "Of Land and Local" exhibits. Her work is in many private collections as well as a permanent installation of public art at the State Police Barracks in Derby VT and the Royalton Department of Public Safety. She was awarded two month long residencies in Reykjavik Iceland by the Icelandic Art Association.
